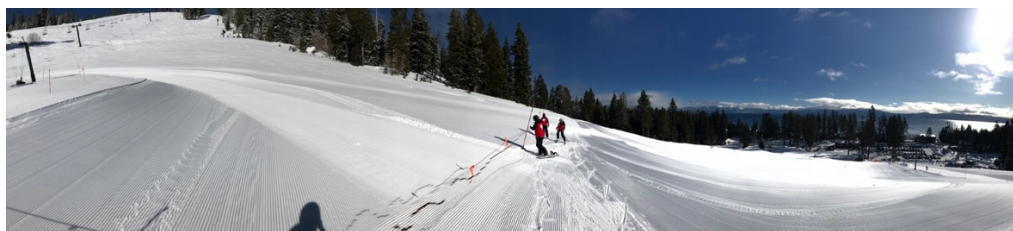


43rd LAKE TAHOE EQUINE CONFERENCE
